ENTRIES

- 1. \$1.00 unless otherwise stated.
- 2. OFFICE ENTRIES CLOSE 4PM 6th May 2025. Late entry form and payment will be accepted with exhibit on delivery.
- 3. GST will apply if an Exhibitor enters an Exhibit as a Business entity, the Exhibitor has an ABN, and the Exhibitor is REGISTERED for GST
 - Where GST applies, the Association will pay the prize money quoted in this Schedule plus 10% GST.
 - The Gympie Show Society will issue a recipient created tax invoice for prize money paid
- 4. Please provide your ABN and GST registration details on entry form if you are entering as a business entity

EXHIBIT DELIVERY AND COLLECTION

- 1. Exhibits are to be delivered to the Pavilion (Arts and Crafts) on the following days and times:
 - a. Thursday 8th May between 3.00pm to 6pm.
 - b. Friday 9th May between 1.00pm to 6pm.
 - c. Saturday 10th May between 8.30am to 12pm.
- 2. Exhibits are to be collected on Sunday 18th May between 10am to 12pm.
- 3. Exhibits not collected on the above date may be collected from the Show Office between 10am and 4pm, Monday to Friday until the 23th May.
- 4. Exhibits not collected by 4pm Friday 23th May shall be disposed of by the Gympie District Show Society Inc.

JUDGING

Judging takes place on Sunday 11th May.

PRIZE MONEY COLLECTION

- 1. Prize Money for all classes to be collected with exhibits Sunday 18th May between 10am and 12pm
- 2. Prize Money not collected at this time will be deemed a donation to the Gympie District Show Society Inc.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. All exhibits must be the original work of the exhibitor, have been executed during the two (2) years preceding the current show and must not have won a first prize at any Gympie Show.
- 2. Any dispute arising over an exhibit the Stewards will make a decision which will be final.
- 3. Awarding of prizes is at the sole discretion of the Judge and should the Judge feel the work in any class is not of a standard to merit an award such award will not be given. In the event of a tie, prize money will be added together and divided by 2 then the next place will be third.
- 4. Each exhibit must have folded identification label with class number etc. at back of picture. This is to be affixed with masking tape on left hand side.
- 5. No 'For Sale' signs.

6. No more than two (2) entries per class per exhibitor.

GENERAL RULES cont..

- 7. All care is taken but no responsibility for breakage or damage.
 - a. Novice is an entry which has not won a first prize at Gympie Show.
 - b. Owing to space restrictions, paintings must be restricted to 1.5m x 1m maximum size.
 - c. Stewards reserve the right to refuse articles deemed to be too heavy.
 - d. No exhibits to be hung by competitors without authority of Stewards.
 - e. No exhibits to be collected by competitors without authority of STEWARDS.
 - f. Loose attachments need to be taped firmly and securely attached to avoid breakages e.g. lids, cruet sets, etc.
 - g. No competitors allowed in the Stewards area.
 - h. Sculpture no more than 1m high x 1m wide.

Presentation of Work

Each entry to be distinctly marked on the back with the artist's name, address, medium, class number and contact number.

All works MUST be ready to hang.

Either:

A. Are to be framed and wired for hanging with D rings, no staples permitted.

B. On a suitable canvas wired for hanging with D rings.

SCRAPBOOKING & CARDMAKING RULES

1 The exhibitors name and phone number should be pencilled on the back of each item or written on a slip of paper and placed inside the plastic sleeve of each entry.

2 Exhibitors are required to ensure permission is given by any third party persons appearing in photographs or mentioned in journalling due to exhibits being on public display.

3 **Pages** – Must be either 12" x 12" (300 x 300mm) or 8 ½" x 11" (A4) finished size and have a suitable for of clear page presentation. Unless otherwise specified, a page exhibit may consist of either a one (single) or a two (double) page spread. Unless double page presentations are securely joined together and noted on the exhibit label as a double page presentation, they will not be considered for judging. **COMPLETED PAGES SHOULD BE ABLE TO BE PRACTICALLY PUT INTO A SCRAPBOOK ALBUM, NO THICKER THAN 5MM (IN DEPTH).**

4 **Cards** - (excluding Class 20017 & 20018**) may be of any dimension up to A5 (210mm x 148mm) or 6"x 6" (155mm x 155mm), finished size, and must be presented in a clear cellophane bag. The inside of card entries will not be displayed or judged. **COMPLETED CARDS SHOULD BE NO THICKER THAN 5MM (IN DEPTH).**

5 Art Journal to be a book no larger than A4 when closed.

6 Artist Trading Cards - Embellishments to be no thicker than 5mm in depth with no overhangs.
