ENTRIES

1. OFFICE ENTRIES CLOSE **6:30PM Tuesday 12th MAY 2026**
2. **NO ONLINE ENTRIES**
3. REMEMBER that all entries must be supplied with attached entry forms (available online and from the office). Entries will not be accepted without this form.

EXHIBIT DELIVERY AND COLLECTION

1. Exhibits are to be delivered to the Show Pavilion on the following days and times:
 - a. Tuesday 12th May between 2pm and 6.30pm **FOR POT PLANTS AND ORCHIDS**
 - b. Wednesday 13th May between 2pm and 6.30pm **FOR CUT FLOWERS AND FLORAL ART**
2. Exhibits may be collected from the Show Pavilion on the following days and times:
 - a. Saturday 16th May between 4pm and 6pm
 - b. Sunday 17th May between 8am and 9am
3. Exhibits not collected on the above dates may be collected from the Show Office between 10am and 2pm, Tuesday to Friday until the 29th May.
4. Exhibits not collected by 4pm Friday 29th May shall be disposed of by the Gympie District Show Society Inc.

JUDGING

1. Judging commences at
 - a. 12pm on Wednesday 13th May **FOR POT PLANTS AND ORCHIDS**
 - b. 7am on Thursday 14th May **FOR CUT FLOWERS AND FLORAL ART**
5. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to record your entry in the correct class. If in doubt, ask a Steward.
6. Points will, on all occasions, be left in the hands of the Judge.
7. If an Exhibitor exhibits in a name other than his or her own name and such exhibits will be awarded prizes (where merited) and points awarded according to the name on the exhibit, i.e. where prizes are awarded on a special points system and a person exhibits in more than one name, they shall, for the purpose of awarding points, be two separate persons.

PRIZE MONEY COLLECTION

1. Prize Money will be paid on Saturday 16th May between 4pm to 6pm and Sunday 8am to 9am.

GENERAL RULES

1. No diseased or pest infected plant will be accepted.
2. Only authorised Stewards allowed in Judging area (if in doubt, check with a Steward).
3. Exhibits in general classes cannot form part of a collection.
4. Should any dispute arise for which no specified rule is laid down, the matter in dispute shall be referred to the Head Steward whose decision shall be final.
5. **BOTTLES ARE PROVIDED FOR CUT FLOWERS.**
6. Entries are accepted entirely at owners' risk. The Society, its members and volunteers will not be liable for any loss or damage to exhibits or any property whatsoever and however such damage or loss occurs. All reasonable care is taken always.
7. A single **EXHIBIT** may be entered into a **SINGLE CLASS ONLY**.
8. Entries must be owned by the Exhibitor for a minimum of THREE MONTHS prior to the show.
